About Sakushal

SAKUSHAL was registered as a charitable Trust in 2023 and started its activities in July 2024. The primary purpose is to provide aid to families of children suffering from cancer in collaboration with two reputed Govt Hospitals in Delhi. This includes gaps in treatment, lodging, nutrition, education, mental health care/counselling, etc.

Our Programs and Impact: Update Apr – Dec 2025

a. Cancer Treatment Assistance Program: From April 2025 till December 2025, Sakushal has helped 473 children with life-saving medicines—**chemotherapy and other drugs, high-grade antibiotics, and PICC lines**—ensuring **no interruption in treatment** due to lack of access or affordability. For many of these children, timely intervention has meant the difference between life and death.

b. Residential Facility Support:

We started a small residential facility in early 2025, near our partner hospitals for 3 children and their caregivers (parents). This safe haven allows outstation families to remain close to treatment facilities without the burden of accommodation and food costs. From April 2025 to December 2025 we offered **765 cumulative stay-days to with basic rations and cooking facility to critically ill children and their families. Four families were the beneficiaries of this initiative.**

c. Outreach for Cancer Support:

Sakushal participated in Childhood Cancer Awareness Month celebrations organized at AIIMS in September 2025. In November 2025, Sakushal had a childrens' book distribution program in the paediatric cancer OPD of Safdarjung Hospital, and interacted with more than 80 children and their caregivers.
